Raise the Barn!



A farmstead needs a barn. Alfa Foundation has pledged to raise \$60,000 to pay for construction of the 40-foot by 80-foot pole barn at Trinity Gardens and Farmstead. In addition Alfa is raising \$10,000 and asking for volunteers to help finish, weatherize and heat a portion of the building for all-weather use as classroom space and other agricultural-related activities for the community. Restrooms and a small kitchen area are planned.

ALFA is asking for your help. \$21,000 has been raised through generous major contributions. A total of \$70,000 is needed to complete planned projects.

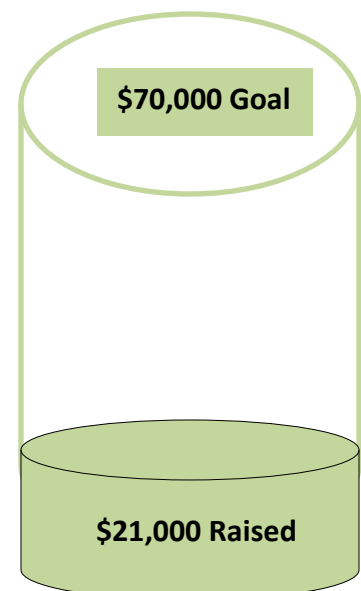
